This application, transcript, the essay and the recommendations must be postmarked to the address below by June 5th. **DO NOT SEND OVERNIGHT POSTAGE.** The postmark by June 5th is fine. You will be notified immediately that your application has been received and is complete. Letters as to the committee's decision will go out mid-late July 2024.

2024 Scholarship Application and Instructions

INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION: Applicant must reside in one of the following SE Iowa counties Des Moines, Henry, Jefferson, Keokuk, Lee, Louisa, Muscatine, Van Buren Wapello or Washington and be a 2024 high school graduating senior. You must answer all the questions on the application form, and you may attach additional sheets. Applicant must have experience with horses and tie their experience to their essay. Please make sure that you sign the signature line. Assemble all the sheets and mail in a normal non-expensive envelope. Do not send anything that requires a signature. No one is home during the day to sign for the item and the post office is closed when I return from work. You will need to send us your high school transcript with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be eligible for this scholarship. This Southeast Iowa Draft Horse Scholarship is worth \$250.00. The scholarship will be paid in August as soon as you have provided your college information. Scholarship can be used to attend the college/university or trade school of your choice. The scholarship money will be sent directly to your college/university's financial office. You will need to provide the committee with your institution's financial aid office address and your account number. In December, at the end of the fall semester it is required that you send a report with your fall college transcripts along with a letter of thanks and how this scholarship has impacted you.
