At least one high school graduate will be the 2025 recipient of \$1500 per year for four years.

Any graduating high school senior residing within the boundaries of the Iowa PGA Foundation and the State of Iowa is eligible to apply. The Iowa PGA Foundation is bounded on the west by U.S. Highway 71 and includes an area of western Illinois from a point north of Quincy, east to near Springfield and directly north.
